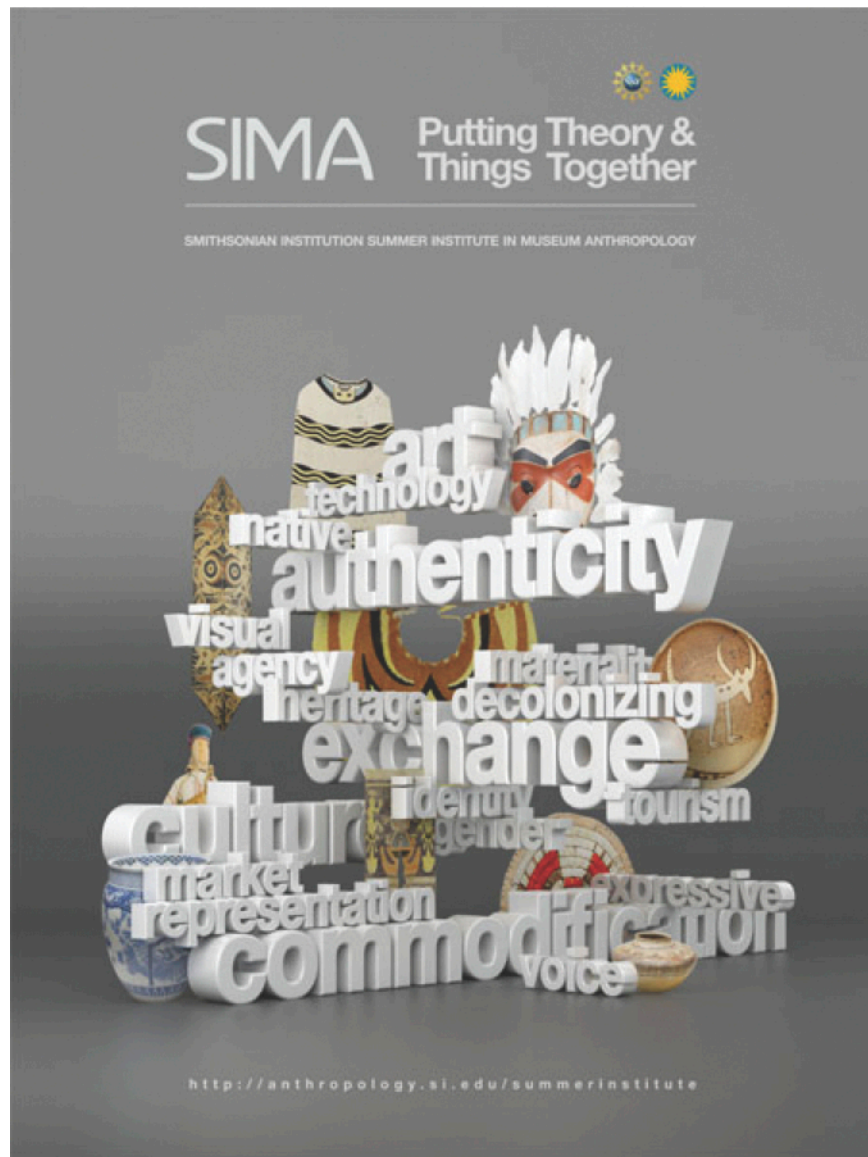


Smithsonian Institution's Summer Institute in Museum Anthropology
